### **Hunter Education Certification Program**

New for 2019, the Summit Bechtel Reserve Hunter Education Certification Program is now able to allow scouts and scout leaders the opportunity to receive their hunter education cards while on site participating in any of our summer programming activities. All you have to do is go to the link for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources registration site (see below) and sign in for the date that matches your week of attendance. Once registered, go to the WVDNR hunter education website and take either the [beasafehunter.org](http://beasafehunter.org) course (which has a fee) or the [WWW.NRAHE.org](http://WWW.NRAHE.org) course (which is free). Once you pass the test, bring your voucher / certificate to the Summit to take the “hands on” application and final course test for certification. Course’s will be taught on Wednesday afternoons from 1:00 – 4:00 in the Joe Crafton Hunter’s Hall building and participants will also get to experience our Laser Shot shooting simulation’s in the Joe Crafton Skills Center. Hunter Education cards will be acceptable in all states.
