What Is The Merit Badge Midway?

The Merit Badge Midway is a single night event that takes place every Tuesday and Thursday at Pigott HQ from 6:00pm-8:00pm. We will have a variety of skilled counselors to help participants start the process for new badges or finish partials that they were struggling to complete at home. **Note the focus of this event is on offering different merit badges, not providing additional opportunities for badges already being offered on our Program Schedule.**

How Can Youth Prepare For This Event Prior To Arriving At Camp?

While there is no sign-up or additional registration required for this event, youth can come prepared by bringing bluecards and any requirements they need to show to a counselor for sign-off. Bluecards can be in the form of partials they are trying to finish, or blank ones for a badge they would like to start during one of the Midways. Black Pug is not used for this event.
